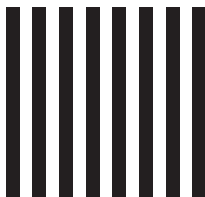

Proposition 84: SAFE DRINKING WATER, NATURAL RESOURCES AND COASTAL PROTECTION

Prop. 84 Protects California's Natural Resources – Our Water, Land and Coastline.

California continues to grow rapidly, placing new burdens on our air, land and water. Prop. 84, a \$5.4 billion statewide bond measure slated for the November 2006 ballot, protects these natural resources, which are vital for our health, economy and quality of life.

Prop. 84 Clean, Safe Drinking Water.

Prop. 84 will help ensure safe drinking water for all Californians by cleaning up polluted waters and protecting them from further contamination. The measure will dedicate funds to protect the water quality of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta – the source of drinking water for 23 million Californians – and to improve the quality of drinking water at the local level.

Prop. 84 Assures a Reliable Water Supply.

Prop. 84 will increase the reliability of California's water supply, through conservation and other programs. According to the state's Department of Water Resources, Prop. 84 will generate more than 1 million acre-feet of new water for California. Every region in the state will benefit from this measure, which funds projects to improve local water supply and water quality.

Prop. 84 Protects California's Coast and Ocean.

California's coastline is one of the most beautiful parts of the state, but coastal areas are being harmed by pollution. For example, toxic runoff from storm drains forced over 1,200 beach closures or advisories last year. Prop. 84 protects our ocean, and beaches all along our beautiful coast - as well as the San Diego, Santa Monica, Monterey and San Francisco Bays.

Prop. 84 Protects California's Rivers, Lakes and Streams.

The health of California's rivers, lakes and streams is continually threatened by pollution from dangerous chemicals, reduced water quality, and destruction of fish and wildlife habitats. Prop. 84 will provide funding to develop river parkways, restore and protect urban streams, and stop contaminated runoff from entering our fresh water.

Prop. 84 Provides Needed Flood Control Improvements.

Experts warn that a major earthquake or series of storms could damage our state's deteriorating system of levees, potentially causing dangerous floods and threatening the delivery of clean, safe water to millions of Californians. Prop. 84 will provide an important step forward toward fixing California's aging flood control infrastructure. The measure designed to complement other efforts underway to clear the huge backlog of needed levee repairs and improvements.

Prop. 84 Protects and Restores California's Parks and Natural Beauty.

Prop. 84 will restore and enhance state parks, which have become overburdened by the state's rapid growth – and provide for greener cities, with safe neighborhood parks. The measure funds projects needed to protect California's forests and wildlife, as well as preserve working forests, farms and ranches. And, Prop. 84 will enhance nature education opportunities at institutions including state parks, natural history museums, aquariums, research facilities and botanical gardens.

Prop. 84 Protects and Benefits Our Economy.

Tourism contributes more than \$88 billion to our state economy and directly supports more than 900,000 jobs. Prop. 84 will protect the natural beauty of California's land, rivers, lakes and ocean, which are vital to drawing visitors to California. Prop. 84 will also help provide a safe and reliable supply of water for California's farms and cities.

Prop. 84 Includes Tough Fiscal Accountability Safeguards.

The measure is funded entirely from existing revenues, and will NOT raise taxes. And, Prop. 84 includes strict fiscal accountability provisions, including yearly independent audits and a citizen's oversight committee.
